Enter from the lower doors on the west side of the building (wheelchair accessible), nearest the traffic circle. The Reunion Welcome Center is on the second floor (elevator available) in front of the Ballroom.

Your name tag, ticket(s), an up-to-date schedule of activities, and additional materials will be available for pick up during **Welcome Center hours of operation:**

- **Friday, June 7, from 10 a.m. - 9 p.m.**
  - *Guests arriving during the Kickoff event (7 - 9 p.m.) must first check in at the Welcome Center to pick up a name tag.*
- **Saturday, June 8, from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.**
  - *If you are planning to arrive just prior to the Block Party on Saturday, pick up your name tag before 1:45 p.m. at the Welcome Center or after 2 p.m. at the Block Party on Center Street.*
